

Retracement of Extension T. 37 N. R. 60 E.

July 3^d 1903.

In attempting to prolong the East boundary of this Township south to its intersection with the south boundary. I had much difficulty in finding the old corners, and some of them are absolutely obliterated. I found the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. sec's 19 and 24 and retraced north but was unable to find the cor. of sec's 13, 18, 19 and 24. I found however what I believed to be traces of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. sec's 13 and 18 very much east of the meridian running through the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec's 19 and 24. I found also traces of the cor. of sec's 7, 12, 13, and 18.

Consisting of imprints of what I believed to be old pits and as these were on the line between sec's 7 and 18 in T. 37 N. R. 61 E. and at a distance 39.52 chs. from
