

Subdivision of T. 37 N. R. 60 E.

July 8th 1903.

At the cor, to sec's 2, 35 and 36 on the S. boundary of T. 37 N. R. 60 E. I set off $41^{\circ} 1'$ on the latitude arc and $22^{\circ} 35'$ on the declination arc and at $7^h 25^m$ determine a true meridian with the solar. The magnetic variation is here $17^{\circ} 58' E.$

Thence I run on random line $N. 0^{\circ} 1' W.$ bet. sec's 2, 35, and 36

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec, cor.

80.00 Fall 20 links E. of cor, to sec's 2, 25, 26, 35^{and} 36,

Thence I run on true line $S. 0^{\circ} 9' E.$ bet. sec's 2, 35 and 36

2.70 Creek 3 links wide S. W.

5.00 Fence S. W. and N. E.

7.00 Ditch S. W.

23.00 Clump of brush

25.00 Leave brush

40.00 Set a quartzite stone $18 \times 10 \times 6$ ins, 12 ins, in ground marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec, cor, to sec's 2, 35 and 36 and built a mound of stones $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft.
