

Retracements of Subdivisions T. 37 N. R. 6 E.

I begin at the cor. of Sec. 2.

7, 12, 13, and 18 on the E. ldy
of T. 37. N. R. 60 E.

I set off $41^{\circ} 4'$ on latitude
arc and $22^{\circ} 22'$ on the de-
clination arc and at
7th 40th l.m.t. determine
a meridian with the
solar. Thence I run a
retracement

E. bet. secs. 7 and 18

39.52

Old cor. lies 39½ links S. of
my line an old decayed
stake now nailed to a fence
post pit and mound en-
tirely disappeared.

80.13

Old cor. lies 80 links S. of
line an old stake nailed
to post pit and mound
entirely obliterated.

I continued the retracement
of the old lines across the
township and while I was
able to find nearly every
corner on which my
work should close they
