

Survey of S. Boundary of T. 37 N. R. 61 E.

July 14th 1903.

At the cor. of Tps, 37 N. Ranges 60 and 61 E. I set off $41^{\circ} 10'$ on the latitude arc and $21^{\circ} 49'$ on the declination arc and at 7^h 18^m P. M. T. determine a true meridian with the solar

Thence I run E. along township line to summit of mountains at 113.33 chs.

At 148.10 chs. I set a great flag on line in a conspicuous position where it may be seen from the eastern boundary of the township.

The summit named at 113.33 chs. is the summit of this great range of mountains and is about 4000 ft above the level of the surrounding valley.

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
