

Subdivisions of T. 37 N. R. 61 E.

Chambers July 17th 1903.

At the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy, of T. 37 N. R. 61 E.

I set off $41^{\circ} 1'$ on the latitude arc and $21^{\circ} 22'$ on the declination arc, and at 7 h. 27 m. l. m. t. determine a true meridian with the solar,

Thence I run,

N. $0^{\circ} 1' W$. bet. secs. 35 and 36.

- 13.60 Gully NE.
- 14.50 Gully NE. with water.
- 19.00 Gully NE. with water.
- 24.12 Run NE.
- 27.00 Draw NE.
- 40.00 Set a granite stone $15 \times 10 \times 6$ ins. 10 ins. in ground marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. to secs. 35 and 36 and raised a mound of stones $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
- Path impracticable.
- 44.00 Head of ravine NE.
- Descend ravine.
- 80.00 Set granite stone $15 \times 12 \times 3$ ins.
