- Lehman's S. $89^{\circ} 30' E.$ bet. sec. 2. 25 and 36
from cor. of sec. 2. 25, 26, 35 and 36.
- 28.00 Ravine S W.
- 40.54 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. to sec. 2. 25 and 36. The cor. in good condition, and marked as described in Surveyor General's notes. E. from $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. sec. 2. 25 and 36.
- 8.30 Ridge S W.
- 15.50 Ravine S W.
- 32.50 Main Ridge N.
- 39.26 Sec. cor. to sec. 2. 25, 30, 31 and 36.
A mound of stones.
At this point I set a granite stone $15 \times 15 \times 15$ ins. 10 ins. in ground marked with 1 notch on S. and 5 on N. edge for cor. to sec. 2. 25, 30, 31 and 36 and built a mound of stones $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor.
