

## Subdivision of T. 33 N. R. 58 E

I began at the cor. to sec's. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. boundary of T. 33 N. R. 58 E. and set off  $40^{\circ}40'$  on the latitude arc and  $8^{\circ}59'$  on the declination arc and at  $7^h 4^m$  L. M. T. determine a true meridian with the solar. The variation of the needle is here  $18^{\circ}16'0''$  E.

Thence I run

N.  $0^{\circ}1'W$ . bet. sec's. 35 and 36

ascend mountain

40.00 Set a granite stone  $28 \times 14 \times 4$  ins.  $21$  ins. in ground marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. to sec's. 35 and 36 and I built a mound of stones  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high W. of cor.

80.00 Set a granite stone  $15 \times 12 \times 8$  ins.  $10$  ins. in ground marked with notch on S.
