

Resurvey 7th Standard N., R. 70 E.

ains

Oct. 21-1903, at 8^h 30^m a.m.
 l.m.t., at the Standard Cor. to
 Tps. 36 N., R. 69 and 70 E.
 (which I rebuild) I set off
 40° 56' on lat. arc and 10° 25'
 S. on decl. arc and determine
 a meridian with the solar-
 gnomon I run E. on S. side of
 Dec. 31- and find no trace
 of cor. 5. and at 256.87 M.S. I
 intersect the line bet. Utah
 and Nevada at 13.22 chs. S.
 of the 26th mile cor. where
 I set a quartzite rock 15x
 12x12 ins, 10 ins in ground
 for closing cor. to Tps. 35 and
 36 N., R. 70 E. mkd. with 6
 notches on N. and S., and 3 on
 W. faces, C C N on W. and U
 on E. faces; raise mound
 of rock 2 ft. base 1 1/2 ft. high
 W. of cor. Pits impracticable.
 As this line is totally oblit-
 erated, I resurvey as follows:-
