

Resurvey of E. boundary of T. 41 N. R. 64 E.

June 10th 1904

Began at the cor. of sec's 2, 13, 18, 19, and 24 on the E. boundary of T. 41 N. R. 64 E. and set off $23^{\circ} 1'$ on the declination arc and $41^{\circ} 24'$ on the latitude arc and at 7^h 5^m

my retracement of the subdivisions in this township had shown me that the latitudinal lines all were inclined at an angle approximating $N. 88^{\circ} W.$ and that it would be necessary for me to run a trial

line due east from the cor. to sec's 2, 9 and 16 and such a line would intersect the east boundary of the township 6.64 chs. $N. 88^{\circ} 19' E.$
 1/4 cor. to sec's 2, 7 and 18 in T. 41 N. R. 65 E.

I therefore determined to run the north half of the east boundary of this
