

Survey of Subdivisions of T. 41 N., R. 64 E.
 Lehigh June 16th 1904.

I began at the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet.
 secs. 9 and 16. and set off 41°
 $25'$ on the latitude arc. and
 $23^{\circ} 22'$ on the declination arc.
 and at 7 h. 30 m. l. m. t.
 determine a true meridian
 with the solar.

Thence I run, on true line,
 East bet. secs. 9 and 16.

 20.00 Ravine SW.
 29.00 Ridge SW.
 40.00 Set a quartzite stone $15 \times 10 \times 8$ ins.
 10 ins. in ground, marked
 with 4 notches on S. and 3 on
 E. edge for cor. to secs. 9, 10,
 15 and 16 and ~~built~~^{raised} a mound
 of stones, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft.
 high, W. of cor.
 Pits impracticable.
