

Resurvey of W. Bdy. of T. 37 N. R. 70 E.

Lehavis

July 2nd 1904.

I set off 41° on the latitude arc and $23^{\circ} 4'$ on the declination arc, and at 7 A. M. L. M. T. determine a true meridian with the solar, at the cor. to townships 36 and 37 N., Ranges 69 and 70 E.

From here I proceeded to examine the west boundary of T. 37 N., R. 70 E.

I retraced the entire west boundary of this township and found the south half of the west boundary of sec. 31 to be 40.00 chs. in length but has a bearing of $N. 0^{\circ} 24' E.$

The north half of the west boundary of this section is 40.00 chs. in length but bears due N.

The west boundary of sec. 30 bears N and is 80.04 chs in length.

The west boundary of sec 19 bears $N 0^{\circ} 37' E$ and is 80.23 chs.
