- lhrs. N bet. secs. 1 and 6.
 40.68 Here I found no trace of old cor. but I set a Granite rock 15 x 10 x 8 ins. 10 ins. in ground marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 1 and 6 and dug two pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. N. and S. $5\frac{1}{2}$ links dist. and raised a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.
- 81.36 I intersect old township cor. a stake and mound as described in Surveyor General's notes.
 I restore this point ^{and set a cedar post} 4 x 4 x 36 ins. 24 ins. in ground marked
 T. 38 N. S. 36 on N.W. face
 R. 69 E. S 1 on SW. face
 T. 37 N. S 6 on SE. face
 R. 70 E S 31 on NE. face
 with 6 notches on N. S. E. and W. edges, and dug 4 pits 24 x 24 x 12 ins. one in each section and raised a mound of earth $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high
