

Supplementary notes on Retracements  
of Subdivisions in T. 87 N.  
R. 61 E.

Apr. 8<sup>th</sup> 1906.

I went to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner  
between sections 9 and 10  
in T. 87 N. R. 61 E. and set  
off  $41^{\circ} 4'$  on the latitude  
arc and  $7^{\circ} 13'$  on the  
declination arc and at  
2<sup>m</sup> 4 m. L.M.T. determine a  
true meridian with the  
solar. Thence I retrace  
N  $0^{\circ} 26'$  W bet. secs. 9 and  
10

40.70

I intersect old stake for cor.  
to secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10. The  
stake was fallen but the  
marks are still legible.

From the cor. to secs. 9, 10,  
3 and 4 I retrace E. bet.  
secs. 3 and 10

40.30

I intersect old stake for  $\frac{1}{4}$   
sec. cor. bet. secs. 3 and  
10. This stake is fallen  
but the marks made by  
the original survey or
