I went to the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner between sections 16 and 17 in T. 37 N. R. 61 E. and set the stone which is of granite $18 \times 16 \times 8$ ins. $.12$ ins. in ground.

The stone is marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face.
