Survey began June 5<sup>th</sup> 1901 with instrument described on page 1 of notes of 154<sup>th</sup> Standard date June 1<sup>st</sup> 1901.

At 7 am I set off  $43^{\circ}38'$  N on lot arc &  $22^{\circ}31'$  incl arc at 4<sup>th</sup> cor to W bdy Sec 20. which is the W bdy of R 35 E and having determined the true Meridian I run Sulk on west Sec 20.
