

## A. Bdy J. 30 N. R 34 E.

Survey commenced June 15<sup>th</sup> 1901 with  
 Inst. fully described June 1<sup>st</sup> 1901 in notes  
 of survey Dyer Standard  
 at 7 am at cor. to Secs 33 & 34 on S.  
 bdy. Set off  $40^{\circ}25'N$ . on lat arc +  
 $23^{\circ}24'N$ . on decl. arc or obtain true Meridian.  
 Cor. in stone mtd. & witnessed as described  
 by Surveyor General.

Next on true line on S. bdy Sec. 33.

Along north slope ascending

35.00 Ridge top

40.00 Set a limestone  $8 \times 10 \times 15$  ins in mound of  
 stone 3ft base 2ft high marked 40 N.  
 for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec cor on S. bdy Sec. 33.

Pits impracticable

55.00 Head of draw Course north

73.25 Set a quartzite  $10 \times 12 \times 15$  ins marked  
 notches on East + 20 West in mound of  
 stone 3ft base 2ft high for cor to Secs 33 & 34

Land mts. - 73.25 chas.

Soil 3rd + 4<sup>th</sup> 70 ft
