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Stdy. T. 28 N R. 33 E.

Survey commenced July 10th 1901
and executed with the instruments
described on page 1 of the Survey of
the Tyler Standard on July 1st 1901

At the cor to T. 28 N R. 33 + 34 E at
7 am July 10th 1901 I set off 40° 15'
on lat arc and 220° 19' on decl arc
or run West on a random line on
the south boundary of this
Township.

At 5 miles and 88.00 Chs. (or
6 miles and 8.00 Chs.) I fall 61 lbs
of old cor which is a spot lying
on mound of stone - marks nearly illegible
I set a post 8x10x16 marked for cor to
Tps 28 N Rge 32 and 33 E set in
a mound of stone 3 ft base 2 ft
high.

At 6 miles 8.55 Chs find trace of
cor of Tps 27 N Rge 32 and 33 E
which I rebuild and freshen
marks on stone, a granite 16x10x
8 ins.

I find notes as given by Surveyor
General to be in error, the Tps
cors being only 60 lbs apart instead of
10.00 Chs.
