

Resurvey of N. bdy. To N.-R. 27 E.

At the cor., to Sp^r, Sand 9 N,
Rgs. 27 and 28 E.

July 20, 1901, at 8 A.M. I. m. t.
Get off. $38^{\circ} 36'$ on

the lat. arc, $20^{\circ} 44.6'$ on
the decl. arc, and determine
the true meridian.

Thence I run $N. 89^{\circ} 43' W.$ on
a blank line bet. Sp^r, Sand
9 N, R. 27 E.

I find at 39 chs. the old 14
sec. cor., 60 lks. N, at 78th chs.,
the sec. cor., 70 lks. N; and
at 40 chain intervals I find
the old corners gradually
facing to the East, and to
the North, irregular distances;
at 394th chs. I find the cor.,
to secs. 5-6-3 and 32. 48 lks.
N, and at 474th chs. the cor.,
to Sp^r, Sand 9 N, Rgs. 26 and
27 E., 5-7 lks. N.

The measurement and
alignment of this N. bdy.
being poor, I resurvey the
N. bdy. as follows; -
