

Resurvey of U. bdy. T. & N. - R. 27 E.

The old cor. to Sp. Sand 9 N. Rqs. 26 and 27 E. is a post partially decayed. in a mound of stone.

I re-establish the cor. at the same point as follows: - Set a granite stone 23x10x10 ins. 14 ins. in the ground for the cor. to Sp. Sand 9 N.

Rqs. 26 and 27 E. marked 9 N. on N. E., 27 E. on S. E., 8 N. on S. W. and 26 E. on N. W.

Sp. Sand; with 6 notches on each edge; raised a mound of stone 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, S. of cor. Pits impracticable.

Thence I run S. on blank line bet. sec. 1 and 6. at 40th chs. I find the 14 sec. cor. 80 lbs. E. at 80th. The sq. cor. 60 lbs. E., then fore I continue the line south. finding at 40 chain intervals the old corners falling to south about 80 lbs. per mile. at 484th chs. I find the cor.,
