

Resurvey T. 7 N. R. 27 E.

Preliminary to commencing
the subdivision of this
township.

I begin at the cor. to Secs.
33 and 34, on the S. Edy. of
T. 7 N. R. 27 E., which is a
trap stone 18x10x6 ins. as
described by Surveyor General.
I re-establish this cor. by
setting a trap stone 24x8x8 ins.
8 ins. in the ground for the
cor. to Secs. 33 and 34,
marked with 3 notches on E.
and N. edges; raise a mound
of stone, 2 ft. base 1 1/2 ft. high,
N. of cor. Pits impracticable.
Thence I run S. 89° 38' N. on
a blank line bet. secs. 4 and
33, at 40²⁶ chs; I find the 1/4
sec. cor. 10 lvs. N. at 80.⁵⁰

I find the cor. to secs. 4-5-
32 and 33, 16 lvs. N. I now
continue on this line
S. 89° 38' N. at 120.⁵⁰ No. 1/4 sec.
cor. at 160⁷² the sec. cor.
38 lvs. N. and at 237⁷² the
cor. to Tps. 6 and 7 N.
