At 7 o'clock A.M. on July 21-1902. At the Cor of T5 1 and 2N Ranges 66 and 67E as re-established and described in Notes of Recovery of E Bdy T1N R66E. I set of $37^{\circ} 56' N$ on Lot Arc $20^{\circ} 36' N$ on Dec Arc and determine the true meridian by solar observation. Knowing that I will face several chains South of the North East. cor. of T1N R65E I run West on a true line to sec 1 and 36 Over rolling land through timber
