I began at the cor. of sec's 25 and 36 on the East boundary of T. 32 N. R. 51 E. and set off  $40^{\circ} 35'$  on the latitude arc and  $22^{\circ} 14'$  on the declination arc and at  $7^m 12^m$  L. M. T. determine a true meridian with the solar

Thence I run

$N. 0^{\circ} 5' E$  on East boundary of sec 25

left bank of Humboldt River

Right bank of Humboldt River

S. P. R. R. track  $S 70^{\circ} E$ .

The cor to sec's 30 and 31, a sandstone,  $30 \times 18 \times 14$  ins marked and described as in Surveyor General's notes.

I rebuilt this corner setting the stone 20 inches in ground and marked with 1 notch on S. and 5 on N. edges and I built a mound of stones  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft base  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft high E of cor.
