I began at the cor of sec 24 and 25 on the east boundary of T. 32 N. R. 51 E. and set off $40^{\circ}36'$ on the latitude arc and $22^{\circ}28'$ on the declination arc and at 7^h 20^m determine a true meridian with the solar

Thence I ran

W bet sec's 24 and 25,

6.00 Ravine S.E.

40.00 Set a granite stone $24 \times 16 \times 8$ ins 18 ins in ground marked with $\frac{1}{4}$ iron N. pole for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec cor and raised a mound of stone $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft base $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft high W of cor.

Pits impracticable

Old cor lies 5 links N and 5 links west this I destroyed

56.00 Ravine S.W.

62.24 Ridge S.

75.80 Ravine S.E.

80.00 Set a granite stone $15 \times 12 \times 5$ ins 10 ins in ground marked with notch on E and 2 on S
