

Survey of N. Bdy. of T. 31 N. R. 47 E.

June 28, 1902.

At 7^h 35^m a.m., l.m.t., I
set off 40° 35' on the lat.
arc: 23° 19' on the decl. arc,
and -determine a true
meridian with the
solar at the cor. of T. 31 N.
R. 47 and 48 E. which is 4.65 chs.
W. of cor. of T. 32 N. R. 47 and 48 E.
Thence I run W. on a random
line, setting temporary
cors. for both Tps. at intervals
of 46.00 chs. those for T. 31 N.
counted from cor. of T. 31 N.
R. 47 E. and those for T. 32 N.
R. 47 E. from cor. of T. 32 N. R. 47 E.
At 475.65 intersected W. bdy
of T. 31 N. R. 47 E. at a point
276.5 of cor.

Thence I run
S. 89° 40' E. on a true line bet
secs 6 and 31.

35.65 Set Lacite stone, 16" x 10" x 8" in
in mound of stones, 2 1/2
ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, for 1/4
cor. of sec. 6 marked 1/4 on
N. face.
