

Resurvey Subdivision lines T. 32 N. R. 47 E.

July 5, 1902..

At 8^h 10^m a.m., l. m. t., I set off 40° 49' on the lat arc and 22° 52' on the decl. arc, and determine a true meridian with the solar at the sec. cor. of secs 5, 6, 7, and 8, ... of Tp. 32 N., R. 47 E.

Thence I retrace the line bet. secs, 6 and 7, 5 and 8, 4 and 9, 3 and 10, 2 and 11, ~~and 12~~ and find the position of corners, and alinement good, but in every case, the stake had fallen and the pits and mound obliterated.

Therefore I find it necessary to resurvey this line and accordingly begin at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.

Thence I run W. bet secs. 6 and 7.
