Survey of Part of E. Bdy. T. 32 N. R. 47 E.
Behr July 8, 1907.

At 8th 15^m a.m., l.m.t. I set
off $40^{\circ} 35'$ on the lat arc.
 $22^{\circ} 34'$ on the decl arc and
determine a true meridian
with the solar at the
cor. of secs. 1 and 12 on the
Range line between Rs.
47 and 48 E and run the
fractional range line S.
on a random.

At ~~47~~^{40 44} 60^{chs} intersect N.
bdy of Tp. 31 N, R. 48 E 4.65 E
of Tp. cor. As this falling
is out of limits, the
point of intersection is
made the cor. of T. 32 N,
Rs. 47 and 48 E.

Set Lacite stone $14 \times 12 \times 8$ in
in mound of stones, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft.
base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, for Tp.
cor. of T. 32 N., Rs. 47 and 48 E.
marked T. 32 N., R. 47 E. on N.W.
face, R. 48 E. on N.E. face with
6 notches on W, N, and E. faces
Pits impracticable.
Thence I run.
