

Resurvey of W. Bdy. T. 20 N., R. 22 E.

May 4, 1903. by A.M. and  
P.M. Solar observations

I determine position for  
true meridian 0.08 and  
0.10 ins. East and West of the  
true meridian established  
by Polaris observation,  
therefore I conclude the  
adjustments of the  
instrument are satisfactory.  
The magnetic bearing  
of the meridian is  
160° 34' E.

I begin at the cor. of  
secs. 19-24-25 and 30 on  
range line bet. Tps. 20 N,  
Rgs. 21 and 22 E. a dilapidated  
mound and undersize corner  
stone which I destroy  
and rebuild as follows.  
Set a Volcanic stone  
16 x 14 x 12 ins. firmly in a  
mound of stone for the  
cor. of secs. 19-24-25 and 30  
marked with 2 notches on  
S. and 4 notches on N. edges  
raise a mound of stone
