 established by me under Cont. 224,
 I set off $39^{\circ}48'N$ on Lot. Arc.
 $20^{\circ}03'N$ on Dec Arc. and
 determine the meridian by
 solar observation. Knowing
 that I will fall more than
 3 Chs S. of the Cor of Tps.
 22 and 23 N R. 24 E I run
 West on a true line bet
 Secs 1 and 36. over Mts
 land ascending.
