

## Resurvey S. Bdy. T. 20 N. R. 24 E.

- Chains. S.  $89^{\circ}17'E$  on a true line along the S. bdy. of sec. 36  
 Over rolling land.
- 25.00 Dry wash course N.
- 40.25 Destroy all traces of old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. and reestablish in original position as follows:  
 Set a volcanic stone  $13 \times 9 \times 6$  ins. 10 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face and raise a mound of stone 3 ft. base  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high N. of cor.  
 Pits impracticable.  
 Thence I run. S.  $89^{\circ}32'E$  from  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. 4
- 44.00 Road leaves N. and S.
- 66.70 Closing cor. of T. 19 N. Rgs. 24 and 25 E. which is a basalt stone  $16 \times 14 \times 9$  ins. marked with 6 grooves on E. W. and S. faces and C.C. on S. face in mound.  
 I recut the mark and set the stone 11 ins. in the ground and raise a mound of stone 3 ft. base  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high S. of cor.  
 Pits impracticable.  
 Begin ascent of a steep slope of ridge.  
 Enter mountainous land.
