

General Description

This Township is rough and broken except along S Bdy where it slopes down into valley of Carson River.

There are several springs in Tp. In SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 11. S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 12. S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 29 S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 28. And S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 30. A Well and old cotin in Sec 15. S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$

There has been considerable timber cut off this land and hauled to Virginia City. The timber is scrub Cedar and pine valuable only for firewood and fence post. Mts very high in West and North west portions gradually sloping to rolling hills in South and East. Considerable bunch grass in Mts and the ^{number} of springs makes this Tp. valuable for grazing purposes.

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
