

Resurvey W. Bdry T. 42 N. R. 34 E.

June 10, 1902.

At the corner common to Secs. 7, 18, 12 and 13 at 7h.08m. l.m.t. I set off 41° 33' N. on Lat. arc and 23° 00' N. on Dec'l arc and determine a true meridian with my solar,
Thence I run

40.

North, between Secs. 7 and 12,
Set a redwood post 4 in. sq. 3 ft. long 2 ft. in ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 S on W. face; dug pits N. and S. on line and raised mound of earth W. of cor. Re-set old cor. to Secs 1 and 12, 6 and 7; a 3"x3"x3' willow post properly marked; dug pits and raised mound of earth W. of cor.; restore markings.

North, between Secs. 1 and 6 .
Re-set stake for 1/4 sec. cor. Re-built pits and mound and freshen marks.
Set a basalt stone 9"x8"x20", 12 ins. in ground in place of old stake for cor. to Tps. 42 and 43 N. Rs. 33 and 34 NE.; marked 6 notches on each face and dug pits 30x24x12 on each line N., E. and W. 4 ft. dist. and S. 8 ft. dist. and raised mound of earth 5 1/2 ft. base by 2 1/2 ft. high S. of cor.

Greasewood and sage brush.
