

Survey of East Boundary of Tp. 42 N. R. 34 E.

June 11, 1902 at 7 o'clock A.M. at the cor. of Tps. 41 and 42 N., R. 34 E. I set off 41° 30' on Lat. arc and 23° 04' N. on Dec'l arc and determine a true meridian with the solar. Magnetic declination 17° 53' East.

Beginning at cor. of Tps. 41 and 42 N., R. 34 E.,

- I run
- 16.20 North, on East boundary of sec. 36,
- 26.50 Wire fence E. and W.
- 40. Cor. of Tps. 41 and 42 N., R. 35 E.
- 47.60 Set a basalt stone 6x8x15, 10 ins. in ground for 1/4 cor., marked 1/4 on W. face; dug pits N. and S. on line and raised mound W. of cor.
- 69.70 Leave greasewood and sage-brush; enter grass.
- 80. Enter Quim River bottom NW and SE; (dry)
- Set a basalt stone 9x5x16, 12 ins. in ground for sec. cor. to secs. 25 and 36 marked 1 notch on S. and 5 on N. faces; dug pits 18x18x12 in these sections, and raised mound of earth W. of cor.
- Level land.
- Soil 2d. and 3rd. rates.
- Greasewood, sage, and grass.
