Chains

I commence at the cor. of secs. 35 and 36 on the 8th Standard Parallel N. which is a quartz stone 15x8x9 ins. above ground, firmly set, and marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.

Thence, I run,

N. 0° 1' N. bet. secs. 35 and 36.

- 1.46 Channel (dry) course S.E.
 1.60 Ascend mountain;
 6.75 Ridge bears S.E. and descend,
 16.30 Bottom and ascend
 21.90 Top, and descend to,
 34.32 Ravine course E.
 34.85 Ascend
 37.86 Ridge bears S.E.
 40.00 Set a quartzite stone 18x12x5 ins. 12 ins in. ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face; raised a mound of stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base 2 ft. high N. of cor. Pits impracticable.
 43.10 Ascend
 60.00 Draw, course N.E. Ascend
 80.00 Set a quartzite stone 12x10x8 ins. 8 ins in ground for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36; marked with 1 notch on E. and S. edges; raised a mound of stone
