

# Reurvey of S. bdy of T. 44 N. R. 55 E.

Chains.

Preliminary to beginning the survey of the subdivisions of T. 44 N. R. 55 E. I retrace the S. bdy.

Beginning at the cor. of secs 34, 5, 32 and 35 I run S.  $89^{\circ}52' E.$  on a blank line, at 40.00 chs. find no trace of  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. and at 80.00 chs find trace of cor. of secs 3, 4, 33 and 34.

I continue on same line and at 117.40 chs. find  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. bet. secs 3 and 34, which is a stone marked and witnessed as described by Surveyor General, at 157.40 chs. intersect cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35. From this cor. which is a stone set marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general, I run S.  $89^{\circ}52' E.$  on a blank line bet. secs 2 and 35 at 39.90 chs. intersect  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. and at 80.25 chs. found remains of cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36. From this cor. I run S.  $89^{\circ}52' E.$  on blank line bet. secs. 1 and 36, at 40.00 chs found traces of  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. at 80.00 chs. found  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. a stone in a stone mound marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor
