

Resurvey of S. Idy. of T. 44 N. R. 55 E.

Chains

As per special instructions I destroy the N.E. cor. of T. 43 N. R. 55 E. and from the point of old cor. I run S. $89^{\circ}52'E$ on a true line bet. secs 1 and 36.

Over broken hills

28.02

Intersect the Ruby Valley Guide Meridian at a point 10.02 chs. S. of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. guide cor. At this point I set a volcanic stone $20 \times 10 \times 8$ ins. 13 ins. in ground for closing of cor. of Tps. 43 and 44 N. R. 55 E. marked with 6 grooves on N. S. and W. faces C.C. on W. T. 44 N. on N., T. 43 N. on S., and R. 55 E. on W. faces; raised a mound of stone 4 ft. base $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of cor. Pits impracticable

Soil clay and gravelly 3rd rate.

Bunchgrass and Sagebrush

Morntamous land 28.02 chs.
