N. 89° 52' W. ^{on a line} bet. sec. 6 and 31.
Draw bars N. Entering mountains, ascend
Top of ridge bears S. N. and N. E. descend
1/4 sec. cor. a volcanic stone firmly
set. 10x6x6 ins. above ground marked
1/4 on N. face. Dug pits 18x18x12
ins. E. and N. of cor. 3 ft. dist.
and raised a mound of earth 3 1/2
ft. base 2 ft. high N. of cor.
Road bears N. W. and S. E.
Ravine, course N. E.
Top of rocky ridge N. E.
Ravine course N. E.
Set a volcanic stone 24x18x8 ins
firmly in a stone mound for cor
of T. 43 and 44 N. Rgs. 54 and 55
E. Marked with 6 grooves on N. S.
E and N. faces and raised a mound
of stone 4 ft. base 2 1/2 ft. high
S. of cor.
