Chains

July, 12, 1902

From the cor. of Tps. 44 and 45 N. Rgs. 54 and 55 E. I ran East on a blank line 504.30 chs. where I intersect the Ruby Valley Guide Meridian 9.55 chs. S. of 1/4 sec. cor.

At this point I set a quartzite stone 17x10x11 ins. 10 ins. in ground for closing T. cor. bet. Tps. 44 and 45 N. R. 55 E. marked with 6 grooves on N. and W. faces, R. 55 E. cc on N. and T. 45 N. on N. faces; raised a mound of stone 3 1/2 ft. base 2 ft. high N. of cor.

Pts. impracticable.

From this cor. I ran

That out a true line between sec 1, 2 and 36 ascending.

38.00 Road bears N and S.

40.00 Set a lime stone 12x8x8 ins. 8 ins. in ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on N. face; dug pits 18x8x12 ins. E. and W. of stone 3 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 3 1/2 ft. base 1 1/2 ft. high N. of cor.

51.00 Radium corner N.E.

60.00 Ditch corner S.W. (from Gold Creek reservoir)
