Chains

July 26 1902 at the cor. of Tps. 44 and 45 N. Rgs. 54 and 55 E. at 8^h00^m A.M. l. m. t. I set off 19°26' on decl. arc and 41°45' N. on lat. arc. and by the solar determine a true meridian.

Thence I run,

North on a true line bet. secs. 31 and 36

Ridge bears S. N.

38.10

Draw course S. N.

42.00

Set a quartzite stone 13 x 8 x 6 ins. 9 ins. in ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on N. face; dug pits

18 x 18 x 12 ins. N and S. of stone 3 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth

3 1/2 ft. base 2 ft. high N. of cor

Head of a draw bears S. E. ascend

60.00

Top of ridge bears E and N. descend

Draw course N.

Set a Basalt stone 15 x 10 x 5 ins. 10 ins. in ground for cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36

marked with 1 notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edges; dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each

sec. 5 1/2 ft. from stone and raised a mound of earth 5 1/2 ft. base 2 ft. high N. of cor.
