

Amended notes.

Retracement of 9th Standard Parallel N.

Chains.

June 12, 1905.

While in the field making corrections Mr. T. M. Sturlbust, Examiner of Survey called my attention to an apparent discrepancy between my work in the northern part of T. 45 N. R. 55 E. and the southern part of T. 46 N. R. 55 E. the work of George W. Bellingier. To make such corrections as necessary I retraced the 9th Std. Parallel N. as follows -

I begin at the N.E. cor. of T. 45 N. R. 55 E. which is 12.85 Chs. N. of the S.E. cor. of T. 46 N. R. 55 E. on the 9th Std. Pll. N. and June 12, 1905 at 8^h 15^m A.M. L.M.T. I set off 239' 21" on dial arc and 41° 50' N. on lat. arc. and by solar observation I determine a true run. Thence I run N. and retrace the 9th Std. Pll. on S. by sec. 36. and at 27.12 Chs. fall to S. of Stand. ^{see} 14th Cor. and at 67.16 Chs. intersect the Stand. sec. cor. of sec. 35 and 36. Thence I run N. on S. by sec. 35 at 40.01 Chs. intersect the Stand. ^{see} 14th Cor. and at 79.11 intersect the Stand. cor. of sec. 34 and 35. From this cor. I run N. on S. by of sec 34 at 39.98 intersect
