

Subdivisions of T. 45 N. R. 55 E.

- Chains. N. 0°5' W. on a true line bet. sec. 5 and 6.
- 4.00 bears aspens
- 4.80 Descend
- 17.80 Enter willows and aspens.
- 24.80 Crossed 5' lts wide 2' Kodjup cross E.
- 31.36 Intersect 9th Std Par. N. 13.36 Chs.
- West of cor of sec. 31 and 32.
- Set a volcanic stone 12x12x7 ins 8 ins in ground for C.C. of sec 5 and 6 marked with 5 grooves on the E, 1 groove on the W. and C.C. on the S face.
- Dug pits 24x18x12 ins crosswise Band N. 5 1/2 ft and S. 8 ft. dist and raised a mound of earth 4 ft. base 2 1/2 ft. high S. of cor.
- One aspen tree 8 ins in dia. bears D. 45° N. 20 lts dist, marked T 45 N. R. 55 E. S. 6. C.C. B.T., One aspen 6 ins in dia. bears D. 30° E. 10 lts dist and marked T 45 N. R. 55 E. S. 5, C.C. B.T.
