

## Fractional S. bdy. of T. 43 N. R. 55 E.

Chains

Aug. 8, 1902

To make the N. E. cor. of T. 42 N. R. 55 E common with the S. E. cor. of T. 43 N. R. 55 E. I marked T. 42 N on S., R. 55 E. on W. and T. 43 N. on N. faces with six grooves on N. S. and W. faces.

The stone was set firmly in the ground with a stone mound 4 ft. base 2 ft. high N. of cor. I rebuilt the mound. Thence I ran

West on a true line bet. Secs. 1 and 36 - ascending over mountainous land.

I intersect the old S. E. cor. of T. 43 N. R. 55 E.

I destroy all traces of this cor. as per. special instructions.
