

Fractional Subdivisions of T. 43 N. R. 55 E.

Chains.

Aug. 8, 1902 at the old S.E. cor. of T. 43 N. R. 55 E. at 9^h 15^m a.m. l.m.t. I set off 16° 18' N. on decl. arc and 41° 35' N. on lat. arc. and by the solar determining a true meridian.

From this old Sp. cor. per special instructions I retrace the old E. bdy. of this Sp., I run,

North on E. bdy. sec 36.

4200 Old 1/4 sec. cor. of which I destroy all traces.

80.19 Fell 70 lks. E. of cor. of secs. 25 and 36. I destroy all traces of this cor.

From the old cor. of secs. 25 and 36 I run

East on a true line bet. secs. 25 and 36.

11.00 Spring branch 4 lks. wide 1 lks. deep flows N.

25.00 Intersect the Ruby Valley Guide Meridian

12.18 Chs. S. of 1/4 sec. Guide cor.

Set a volcanic stone 18x10x5 ins.

12 ins. m. ground for closing sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 36. marked with 1 groove on S. and 5 grooves on N. faces and C.C. on N. face; dug pits 24x18x12 ins. crosswise on each line N.E. 3 ft. and N. of stone 7 ft. dist; and raised a
