

Resurvey E. bdy of T. 42 N. R. 52 E.

Chains.	July 12 1903, at 6 ^h 30 ^m A.M. C.M.T. at cor. of Tps. 41 and 42 N. R. 52 E. as reset by me I set off 22° 07' on decl. arc. and 41° 29' N. on lat. arc. and by the solar determine a true meridian, thence I retrace the E. bdy of T. 42 N. R. 52 E., N. on a flat line and at
40.31	find remains of old stone $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bt. secs. 31 and 36 and at
80.31	remains of old stone mound which was doubtless old cor. of secs 25, 30, 31 and 36.
	Thence I retraced N. between secs. 25 and 30 and at
40.00	find remains of old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. at stone firmly set in as stone mound as described by the surveyor general, at
85.00	find old cor. of secs 14, 24, 25 and 30. which was a stone set and marked as described by surv. general.
	Thence I ran north bt. secs. 19 and 34 and at
4000	find no traces of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor and at
79.40	find, what is doubtless old cor. of secs. 13, 18, 24 and 19
	Thence I ran, N. bt. sec. 13 and 18 at
40.00	find no traces of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. at
