Chains. West on a true line bet secs. 7 and 18.

Descend steep through aspens and Laurel Ravine course N.W. and ascend.

40.00

Set a quartzite stone $24 \times 10 \times 8$ in. 18 in. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, raised a stone mound $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base 2 ft. high N. of cor.

Ascend.

Top of ridge leave N and descend through rocks and bush.

Leave bush enter gorge of large loose rocks head S.W.

94.00

Leave rocks.

Intersect the N. by 150 Chs. S of cor. of secs. 12 and 13. Set a quartzite stone $18 \times 6 \times 6$ in. 12 in. in ground for c.c. to secs 7 and 18, marked with 4 grooves on S, 2 grooves on N and c.c. on E. face. Raised a stone mound 4 ft. base 2 ft. high E. of cor. Ptho impracticable.
