

Resurvey of E. Tdy. T. 41 N. R. 52 E. and
Chains part of the 8th 1st Pl. N.

June 1, 1905.

From the N.E. cor. of T^p 41 N. R.
52 E. I retraced S. on a plank line
and find no traces of old corners till
at 126.81 Chs. fell 52 Ws. E. of
^{cor of sec 7}
1/4th Sec State in a mound of stone marked
as described by Sur. Genl. From this
1/4 cor I run S on old line at 4014 Chs
find the old mound and state of the
cor. to sec 12 and 13. Thence, I run
S. and find nothing till 122 Chs.
find old mound and rotten state of
1/4 cor bet sec 19 and 24 as described
by the Sur. Genl. Thence N. on
old line 40 Chs find old state
and mound of stone which was the
cor of sec 24 ~~and~~ 25, and 30
Thence I continue S. at 40 Chs.
find trace of old 1/4 cor. and at
80 40 Chs. find mound but no state
which is evidently the old cor.
of sec. 25, 30, 31, and 36. I continue
South at 40^{Chs} find no traces of old
1/4 cor. at 79.20 I intersect Sta. fall. 60
W. of the cor. of T^p 41 N. R. 52 and
53 E. as read by me at 9.20 Chs.
