- No. 14' E. bet. ^{secs.} 1 and 6 asc.
- 1.10 Small stream 2 lks wide and 1 lks deep course S.W.
- 9.25 Top of ridge, ^{bears N.} descend.
- 15.25 Bottom of ravine, course N. ascend
- 16.33 Top, begin descend.
- 19.00 Bed of canon, course S.W.
- 40.20 Top of round hill, descend,
- 42.27 Can find no trace of old ^{1/4 Sec} cor. therefore
I set a slate stone 19 X 10 X 8 ins. 16 ins
in ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked
1/4 on N. face and raised a mound

in mound of stone. I replace slate by
putting a quartzite stone 20 X 10 X 10 ins.

42 N. R. 52 E. marked ^{with} 6 notches on
N. N. and S. faces and raised a mound
of stone 3 ft. base 2 1/2 ft. high N. of cor.
