Amended Field notes of N. bdy of T. 43 N. R. 57 E.

Chains

Apr. 24, 1905.

I began at the

N.E. cor. T. 42 N. R. 56 E. and ran N. on a base line at 44.92 chs. fell 6.49 chs. E. of $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. on N. bdy Sec. 31 of T. 43 N. R. 57 E. which was a stone set in ground marked and witnessed as described by Sur. Genl. From this $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. I ran N. and at 40.22^{chs.} fell 33 lks. E. of Cor. of secs. 31, 30, 25 and 36. which is a stone set and marked as described by Sur. Genl. From this cor. I ran N. bet. secs 25 and 30 and at 40.40 chs fell 25 lks E. of old pits and mound of $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. and from this $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. I ran N. 39.77^{chs.} fell 36 lks E. of cor. secs. 24, 25, 30 and 19 a stone set marked and witnessed and described by Sur. Genl. From this cor. I ran N. bet. secs 19 and 24 at 40.00 chs. find no trace or sign of $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. and at 85.38^{chs.} fell 1.97 chs. E. of cor. ^{to secs} 19, 18, 13, and 24. marked and set as described by Sur. Genl.

Began at this cor. and ran north bet. secs 18 and 13 and at 39.54 chs.
