At 7:15<sup>am</sup> A.M. C.M.T. I set off  $41^{\circ}40'$  True  
 lat. circ. and  $14^{\circ}05'16''$  N. on decl. circ.  
 and at the cor of Tps. 43 and 44 N. R.  
 56 E. on the Ruby Valley Guide Mer.  
 I determine a true meridian by solar  
 observation.

Thence, I run,

East on a true line bet. secs. 31  
 and 6.

- 2.10 Ravine and spring branch 2 lks wide 1 lk.  
 deep. course N., ascend slope,  
 15.00 Ridge bears N.  
 22 Ridge bears N.  
 35.05 Dry ravine course N.N., ascend  
 40.00 Set a volcanic stone  $18 \times 10 \times 3$  ins  
 12 ins in ground for 14 sec. cor.  
 marked 74 on N. face, dug pits  
 $18 \times 18 \times 12$  ins. E and W. 3 ft. dist. and  
 raised a mound of earth  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. tall  
 2 ft. high N. of cor.  
 42.00 Ridge bears N.E., descend  
 47.00 Draw course N.E., ascend  
 49.00 Top of ridge bears N.  
 50.00 Draw, course N.  
 61.00 Point of ridge bears N.  
 63.00 Head of draw course N.N.
