

Reurvey of the S. bdy of T. 37 N. R. 23 E.

Chains Aug. 24, 1906. I reestablish Cor.
of Tps 36 and 37 N. Rs 23 and
24 E. in same place of original
Cor. (which was a volcanic
stone $10 \times 8 \times 6$ ins which I
destroyed) by setting a
volcanic stone $20 \times 12 \times 6$ ins
15 ins in the ground marked
37 N. on N.E. 24 E. on S.E. 36 N.
on S.W. and 23 E. on N.W. face
and with 6 notches on N.,
E., S and W. edges. raise
mound of stone 3 ft. base,
2 ft. high S. of Cor.

Pits impracticable.

thence I run West
on S. bdy sec 36.

Over mountainous land
ascending.

- 6.60 Spur slope N.E. descend.
16.50 Ravine Course N.E. ascend.
31.00 Spur slope N.E. descend.
40.00 Set a volcanic stone $16 \times 12 \times 6$ ins
11 ins in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$
sec. Cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, raise
a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft high
N. of Cor. Pits impracticable.
