General Description—
With the exception of a
small portion of sec. 2 and 3,
this township is all
mountainous.

The ridges are generally
high, broken and rocky,
with very little soil,
are covered with sagebrush,
and greasewood, with quite
a growth of bunchgrass.
They are valueless except
for grazing. The northern
portion of sec 2 and 3,
is a part of a creek
bottom, covered with
a black loam, and
carries a dense growth
of sagebrush.

There are three small
streams in the Twp. each
of which are dry the
greater portion of the year,
except that the water
occasionally raises to
the surface.
